WAYS TO VOTE

ABSENTEE VOTING

Must be eligible. Includes permanent absentee voting.

You may vote by absentee ballot if you are unable to appear at your assigned polling place on Election Day for a reason permitted by state law.

Request an absentee ballot by email, mail, or fax at de.gov/absenteeapp.

You may also call your county elections office to have an absentee ballot application sent to you.

ELECTION DAY VOTING AT YOUR ASSIGNED POLLING PLACE

Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day.

Your assigned polling place is listed on the Polling Place Card attached to this mailer. Call your county elections office with any questions.

Primary Election Early Voting Dates and Times:

- August 28 31, 2024: 11 a.m. 7 p.m. and September 3, 2024: 11 a.m. - 7 p.m.
- September 4 8, 2024: 7 a.m. 7 p.m.

General Election Early Voting Dates and Times:

- October 25 29, 2024: 11 a.m. 7 p.m.
- October 30 November 3, 2024: 7 a.m. 7 p.m.

IMPORTANT VOTER REGISTRATION **DEADLINES!**

Voter Registration Deadline for the State Primary Election (if not currently registered):

Saturday, August 17, 2024

Voter Registration Deadline for the General Election (if not currently registered):

Saturday, October 12, 2024

NOTE: The deadline to change party affiliation to vote in the State Primary Election was Friday, May 24, 2024.

ID REQUIREMENTS TO VOTE

When voting in person, either at an early voting site or at your assigned polling place on Election Day, you will be asked to present your ID.

If you are unable to present ID and are an active voter at your correct polling place, an election officer will verify your voter information. Once your registration status has been confirmed, you will complete an Affidavit of Affirmation of Voter Identity and will then be permitted to vote.
